Cipher use the first letters of the lines E, A, N, I respectively:



SPY LYRA

Lyra (from Greek *λύρα*) is a constellation. Its name derived from the lyre, a stringed musical instrument... Lyra was one of the 48 constellations listed by the 2nd century astronomer Ptolemy,

Vega is also part of the asterism known as the **Summer Triangle**, consisting of the brightest stars in the constellations Lyra, Aquila, and Cygnus.
